





Myracle Cromwell, daughter of Natasha Gaillard and sister of Mycah, graduated from James Island Charter High.



Terrylin Dais-Pasley



Haley Gumm



Her career plan includes attending the University of North Carolina Chapel Hill to obtain her Master of Public Health. She says that "What comes next will be the plans God has written for me."


Raven's interests/hobbies are maternal and child health and community service.


